#### ROBERT ARMSTEAD - REVOLUTIONARY WAR

Robert Armstead is buried in the Mount Pleasant Methodist Church Ceme-tery in District 8 of Montgomery County, Tenn. about 10 miles northwest of Clarksville off Highway 79.

On one stone is: ROBERT ARMSTEAD June 29, 1761 - Sept. 8, 1853 A Revclutionary Soldier. MARY A., wife of Robert Armstead, May 19, 1776 -March 18, 1853.

Robert Armstead Jan. 4, 1804 - June 26, 1867 Another stone is:

Will of Robert Armstead made Oct. 1846 - Rend. Oct 1853 mentions wife, Mary.

Sons: John, Robert, Richard A., and Jesse

Daughters: Polly T., Betsy Ford, formerly Betsy Frazier. Children of daughter Betsy by first husband, James Frazier, to wit: Henritta, Rosanna, and Elizabeth Frazier.

Children of daughter Mary Goodwin

SAMUEL SMITH - REVOLUTIONARY WAR

Samuel Smith is buried in the Smith cemetery near the site of Old Asbury Church. This is now in Fort Campbell, Kentucky. The last land owner was G. M. Smith. It is located on Engineer Road.

His stone reads: Samuel Smith died Jan. 16, 1837 age 75 yrs. A Soldier of the Revolutionary War. 67

Another stone reads: Wiley Smith born in Granville Co., N. C. died Oct. 10, 1872 - Age 74 yrs.

There is a Griffith grave, Fuqua and two Smiths (from <u>Cemetery Records</u> of Fort Campbell, Kentucky .)

### JESSE COOKSEY WAR of 1812

Jesse Cooksey born in Va. 1793 died 1866. "When seventeen years old participated in the War of 1812" He married Sarah Heathman who was born 1803 and died 1882. One of their children was Enoch N. Cooksey who was born Dec. 6, 1841 and married Mary Dority who was born July 18, 1851. (Goodspeed's History of Tennessee, page 1020)

I remember Enoch N. Cooksey or Mr. Newt as he was called. He was a veteran of the Civil War. Mary Dority was the daughter of John and Emily (Tolar) Dority. Emily Dority is buried in the Trice-Leigh Cemetery. May 11, 1822- Jan 6, 1893. She married John Dority 1843. His footstone is there but the head stone is gone.

Enoch N. and Mary (Dority) had seven children: Virginia who married Jim Foster; Lilly who married Will Parker; Frances who died unmarried; Newt died unmarried; James Calvin died unmarried, Tim and Ernest married but died without issue. (from my Tolar records. AWD)

#### WILLIAM CRUTCHER - REVOLUTIONARY WAR

Research so far has not established his birth, death and marriage. It is assumed that he was born in Spotsylvania Co., Va. A soldier in the Revolutionary War. Came to Nashville in 1784 and purchased land on the same day as Anthony, his brother. He moved later to Montgomery Co., Tenn. He was scalped by the Indians and left with a knife sticking in his back on Blooming Grove Creek west of Clarksville. He recovered from this experience. (from PECK FAMILY, p. 57 by William Greer Peck, 5705 Rosario, Atascadero, Calif. 93422)

This was in 1786 (Along the Warioto by Ursula S. Beach)

#### ANTHONY CRUTCHER - REVOLUTSONARY WAR

No birth, death, etc. records. He was a Lt. with the North Carolina troops in the Revolutionary War and served to the end of the war. A land transfer in Spotsylvania Co., Va. links him to Surry Co., N. C. It is believed that he married a Binkley about 1795. He was appointed to Court, Pleas & Quarter Sessions by Gov. Wm. Blount of Tennessee Co. Anthony was a noted Indian fighter on the Red River. He was on the commission that laid out and established the town of Clarksville, Tenn. in 1785 (from THE PECK FAMILY, page 57)

He died Jan. 2, 1814 while home on leave. Died in Montgomery Co., Tenn. (from Alfred McCroskey, 2271 Shade Ave., Florence, Ala. 35630)

#### THOMAS B. CRUTCHER JR. - WAR of 1812

Thomas B. Crutcher, Jr. born Nov 18, 1769 in Virginia. He married Catherine Smith Jan. 13, 1796 in Franklin Co., Va. Catherine was born May 11, 1771-died Sept. 24, 1835 in Hardeman Co., Tenn at Whiteville. Thomas B. Crutcher Jr. was the son of Thomas B. Crutcher Sr.. There were seven children:

Thos. B. Crutcher Jr. served 2 enlistments in War of 1812 - enlisting May 13, 1812 in Col. Henry H. Bryan's 6th Brigade and Jan. 14, 1813 in Capt. James Hambleton's Co. He moved to Bowie Co., Texas between 1835 and 1837. He lived with his daughter, Margaret, and Mr. Sanders in Mississippi in his late years. (from Mr. Alfred McCroskey, 2271 Shade Ave., Florence, Alabama 35630)

#### THOMAS WALTON ATKINSON - WAR of 1812

Thomas Walton Atkinson (1777 - Feb. 7, 1862 Montgomery Co.) md. Lizzie Humley (---- d. 1809) : Srgt. Capt. Butler's Co., Ky. Mil 9-18-1812 -- 10-12-1812 and Capt Ky. Vol. Mil. 8-24-1813 for 3 mos. at Battle of Thames; W D & Ky S A & P D; Clarksville, Montgomery Co. Pvt mkr. ( Soldiers of the War of 1812 Buried in Tennessee

Thos. W. Atkinson married Betsy Carlile Nov. 5, 1810 in Green Co., Ky. John Carlile was bondsman. Betsy was the daughter of John and Sarah (Cates) Carlile. The Atkinson were in Montgomery County, Tenn. by 1819.

Thos. W. Atkinson made his will 24 April 1858 names second wife, Elizabeth and her children: Sally Lackey, Quinttia Clark, Representatives of Joshua Atkinson and representatives of Sherwood S. Atkinson. The children and grandchildren of first wife: Frances Mason, formerly Frances J. French, Elizabeth Trabue and Q. C. Atkinson. 7 heirs in all. He mentions Dr. Jno Trabue in his will.

Elizabeth Carlile Atkinson died 1881. Quintta Atkinson married Beverly Clark Aug 29, 1846. T. W. Atkinson married Henritta E. Trice Jan 25, 1847 and died before his father and without issue as he is not mentioned in the will. Sally married first a Harris and then John W. Lackey. Joshua Atkinson married Elizabeth A. Watkins 1838 in Todd Co., Ky. and left one son, Quint Atkinson. (from my Carlile-Trice records. AWD)

# PAUL CASTLEBERRY - WAR of 1812

Noncupative Will of Paul Castleberry decd. proven by William Holloway and William Hust. Made just before he went to Orleans. There is no date but on the same page is dated July term 1815. He names his brother-in-law, John Trice, nephew, Franklin Trice and brother, John Castleberry. (Will Book B, Montgomery Co., Tenn. page 281)

John Trice is administrator of Paul Castleberry decd. - made 18 July 1815. Edward Trice and Thos. Bunch were bondsmen (Will Book B., p.279)

John Trice married Nancy Castleberry.
