SOLDIERS FROM MONTGOMERY CO., TENNESSEE in the Revolutionary War and War of 1812

THEOPHELUS WILLIAMS - Revolutionary War.

The Hon'ble the Legislature of Tennessee.

The petition of Daniel Williams of Montgomery County humbly sheweth—That a Land warrant issued to the Heirs of his father Theophelus Williams for 1096 acres of land for his services as an officer in the Revolutionary War—That said warrant was sent to this country whilst he was a minor—that a location was subsequatly made in the office at Nashville in the name of Daniel Williams, heir of Theophelus Williams—Upon application for a grant it was refused upon two grounds—viz because there was a variance as above stated between the warrant and the entry—& because there were other heirs viz five sisters of said Daniel now living.

Your petitioner therefore prays that a law may be passed authorising a grant to issue to the Heirs of Theophilus Williams agreeably to the entry made in the name of the said Daniel Williams heir of Theophilus Williams--and your petitioner shall forever pray, etc.

CAPT. JOSEPH P. THOMAS SR. - War 1812

Capt. Joseph P. Thomas, Sr. was an architect of Winchester, Va. who commanded a company in the War of 1812 that he equipped at his own expense. He came to Todd Co., Ky. in 1822, removed to Clarksville, Tenn. in 1829 and died there in 1835. His wife was Sarah C. Duvall of Maryland. There were 9 children. Dr. J. P. Thomas was the youngest born in Clarksville, Tenn. Sept 9, 1830. He died Sept. 11, 1893 in Hopkinsville, Ky. He married Louisa J. Radford in 1854 (dau. of Joseph A. & Mary (Sargent) Radford. BOOKS

FOLLOWING THE BRASWELLS ON THE MOVE WESTWARD IN AMERICA 1600-1974 by Dr. R. B. Braswell, 1723 Dogwood Lane, Pampa, Texas 79065. 8 x 11 soft cover. 109 pgs. Memeographed and offset. \$1.50.

Dr. Braswell has done a masterful job of collecting Braswell information. He has brought some of the descendants of Richard Braswell of London and his son, Robert b. 1612, Isle of Wright, Va. to the present generations. He has a collection of lineages from various parts of the country. His text is easy to read and well sprinkled with dates and places. A visual chart further simplifies the family genealogy. Documentation is substantiated in many cases by wills, Bible records, census records, tax lists which are included in the book. There is, for instance, a Tabulation of All Breazeales, Brawsells, and Brazils who Appear on the Indexes of Microfilm Records in the National Archives in Washington, D. C. (This includes Revolutionary War, War of 1812, Indian wars, and Mexican War). Also included are these names on the 1790 Census of North Carolina, 1830 Census of Georgia, 1840 Census of Tennessee and the 1880 Soundex Indes for Tennessee and Texas.

MINOR, SCALES, COTTRELL, AND GRAY FAMILIES OF VIRGINIA, NORTH CAROLINA, AND MISSISSIPPI compiled and edited by Martha Neville Lumpkin. Published by Ben Gray Lumpkin, Route 3, Box 391, Clarksville, Tenn. 37040. 133 pages, 8½ x 11, Soft Cover, Off Set printing. \$8.00.

This is one of the most delightful family histories I have ever read. The biographical sketches are full of happy memories and anecdotes as well as genealogical data. Family group sheets for each branch are a great help in keeping everyone in his proper place. Military Records, letters, pictures and other documentations add further to this well done book. As an extra help it is punched for a three ring binder which enables a descendant to add his line or additional information in its proper place.

Dr. Lumpkin has also published two more books:
